

Construction of upgrades and improvements to The Verona Wastewater Treatment Facility Primary Clarifier Pump Station Upgrades at the Wastewater Treatment Facility on 10 Commerce Court Verona, NJ 07044 with a capital cost of \$1,238,880.00, were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits by replacing pumps, motors, motor control panels, check valves and repairing miscellaneous structural repairs. This will improve the treatment processes at the Wastewater Treatment Plant for residents and businesses in Verona, NJ.
